



WAYLAND YOUTH SOCCER (WAYS) SPRING, 2010 PROGRAMS: BOYS AND GIRLS TEAMS

REGISTRATION: Kindergarten \$75, Intramural (Grades 1,2) \$90; BAYS (U9–14) \$130 and (U16–18) \$90
DISCOUNT: There is a \$25 discount for each child beyond the second family participant.
LATE FEES: Registration forms for players Grades 3 to 8 postmarked after October 31, 2009 are considered late and subject to a \$25 late fee; \$40 after November 30. Only one late fee assessed per family. Corresponding intramural late dates are February 1, 2010 and March 1, 2010.

BOSTON AREA YOUTH SOCCER (BAYS)

- Competitive travel team format, 5 home, 5 away games on weekends; each team may have up to 2 practices per week. U16 Through U18 games are held on Sundays
- BAYS programs requires a commitment to attending games and practices.
- Age groups:
 - U18 Born on or after August 1, 1991 and before or on July 31, 1993
 - U16 Born on or after August 1, 1993 and before or on July 31, 1995*
 - U14 Born on or after August 1, 1995 and before or on July 31, 1996*
 - U13 Born on or after August 1, 1996 and before or on July 31, 1997*
 - U12 Born on or after August 1, 1997 and before or on July 31, 1998*
 - U11 Born on or after August 1, 1998 and before or on July 31, 1999*
 - U10 Born on or after August 1, 1999 and before or on July 31, 2000*
 - U9 Born on or after August 1, 2000 and before or on July 31, 2001*

* Under age players will be moved up to their grade level.

PLAYER PLACEMENT ON BAYS TEAMS

- Players are placed on teams according to their skill level. WAYS uses player evaluations when necessary to assess skill levels of all players.
- Players registered by the **DEADLINE** are given first consideration for a place on a team based on their skill level. Tryouts will be held if too many players register for available spots.
- Players not registered by the **DEADLINE** will be placed on a team of the appropriate skill level if space is available on a first come first served basis.
- If not enough players are registered to form a team, and/or if no parent volunteers to coach that team, registration fees will be returned.
- Age groups may be combined if one or both of the age groups do not have enough players to form a team.
- Players will not be allowed to wear earrings during games.
- Players young for their grade will be played up to their grade level.

INTRAMURAL PROGRAM

- An in-town recreational program for grades K, 1 and 2
- Combined Game/Practice on Saturdays.

HOW TO REGISTER

- Fill out and send form in by mail.
- Grade 3 through 8 registrations postmarked after October 31, 2009 are subject to late fee.
- No requests for team placement will be honored. No refunds after January 7th

VOLUNTEER YOUR TIME AS A COACH IN BOTH BAYS AND THE INTRAMURAL PROGRAMS

- **Coaches, assistant coaches and managers are always needed;** no experience required.
- WAYS offers coaching clinics, training manuals, books, video tapes, etc. for coaches. If you can't attend practice and games, then you can help by being a manager and helping with team management such as scheduling, phone calls, etc.
- WAYS will refund the course fee for a G, F, E or D coaching license and rebate the registration fee for one child of any coach or manager who earns an F, E or D coaching license.
